

VATSALYA TRUST, MUMBAI – GUIDELINES FOR FUNCTIONS / CELEBRATIONS IN VATSALYA PREMISES

Birthdays and functions can be celebrated with the children on any Saturday or Sunday between 10 am and 12 noon or from 4 pm to 6 pm.

The main objective of celebrating functions with the children is to provide them with the love, care, and affection they might miss out on due to not being a part of a family. Furthermore, it sensitizes individuals to their contributions towards society.

Here are a few guidelines for celebrations:

- Please refrain from donating used clothes and toys, or bringing externally cooked food for the residents.
- A non-creamy, branded slice cake or Frooti may be allowed.
- Donations of fruits, dry fruits, and grocery items like cereals, cooking oil and rice are permitted.
- Sponsoring a full day's meal for inmates costs Rs. 7,000/-, and half a day's meal costs Rs. 3,500/-. A minimum donation of Rs. 5,000/- is requested for celebrations within Vatsalya Premises.
- Puppet shows, drawing competitions, magic shows, etc., can be organized with prior notice to encourage greater participation from the children. Soft music is also permitted.
- Kindly avoid giving gift items or eatables directly into the hands of the children, as many of them are differently abled.
- Please inform us in advance about the number of guests invited for the function.
- All participants must adhere to the trust's rules and regulations.
